

HOW TO GET TO COPENHAGEN

The **recommended airport to the meeting is Copenhagen Airport (CPH)**. It is very close to the city centre (15 min metro ride). You can transport by bus, train and metro to and from the airport, but the metro is recommended.

How to get from the airport to the city center:


Metro (<https://intl.m.dk/>): The metro station is located in extension of Terminal 3. The Metro runs at 4–6 minute intervals during the day and evening hours and at 15–20 minute intervals at night.

Train: Regional and intercity trains link the airport with several stations in the city center (Copenhagen Central Station, Vesterport, Nørreport and Østerport). The ticket office is located in Terminal 3, immediately above the railway station.

Bus: There are several bus lines to and from the center of Copenhagen.

How to get from the airport to the University:

The easiest way to go from the airport to the University is by metro. It takes approximately 30 min. Take the M2 line (direction Vanløse) from the airport to Kongens Nytorv St. and change to the M3 line (via Østerport) to Vibenshus Runddel St. From the station, there is a 500 m walk to the University (see map below). Please note that the metro is faster and much cheaper than a taxi. **Remember that COST does not reimburse taxis unless in very specific circumstances.**



SUGGESTED HOTELS FOR COST WORKSHOP IN COPENHAGEN JANUARY 2020

Copenhagen offers quite a selection of accommodation options, but the hotels are in general expensive and booked. As the meeting location is close to a Metro station (Metro station Vibenshus Runddel St), I would suggest you look for hotels close to a Metro station. Also, there is a number of fast (15 min) bus lines (15E, 150S, 184 and 185) from Nørreport Station to the University (bus stop Vibenshus Runddel), so a hotel close to Nørreport Station may also be very convenient.

Remember that if you are claiming COST reimbursement for this meeting, **hotels will be reimbursed at a flat rate of 120 € per night (including breakfast)**, which may be difficult to find, so have this in mind when booking (you may book a more expensive hotel, but you will not get reimbursed for hotel expenses over 120€ per night).
