

WORKSHOP DINNER THURSDAY JANUARY 23th at 19.30

The restaurant: The workshop dinner will take place at restaurant Tårnet, Christiansborg Palace: <https://taarnet.dk/?lang=en> (see map below). The tower is the property of the Danish Parliament, whose Members took the initiative to open it – for the pleasure of all those who live in or are visiting Copenhagen. For security reasons, there is a scanner at the entrance. As a rule, a security check – similar to the way people are scanned at airports – takes only a few minutes. The view from the tower of Christiansborg Palace is very nice – Copenhagen’s highest tower, which is open to the public. The tower closes at 9.00 pm, so if you would like to enjoy the view from the tower, you should do it before the dinner.

Public transport: It is easy to get to the tower by public transport. You can plan your journey at www.rejseplanen.dk. Enter “Christiansborg” as your destination. The closest metro station is Gammel Strand Station. The following buses stop near Christiansborg; 1A, 2A, 26, 40, 66 and 350S. The closest railway stations are Copenhagen h and Nørreport.

Registration and payment: Please register separately for the dinner no later than January 14th 2020 to Camilla Foged (camilla.foged@sund.ku.dk). Please notice that the dinner is only partially funded by COST for COST members and speakers, so there is a charge of 45 € per COST participant/speaker for the dinner. Non-COST participants are also welcome for the dinner (limited number of seats), but for a price of 90 €. Please pay in cash or by mobile pay (+45 21 63 34 64) to Camilla before the dinner. The price includes a three-course menu, wine and coffee.
